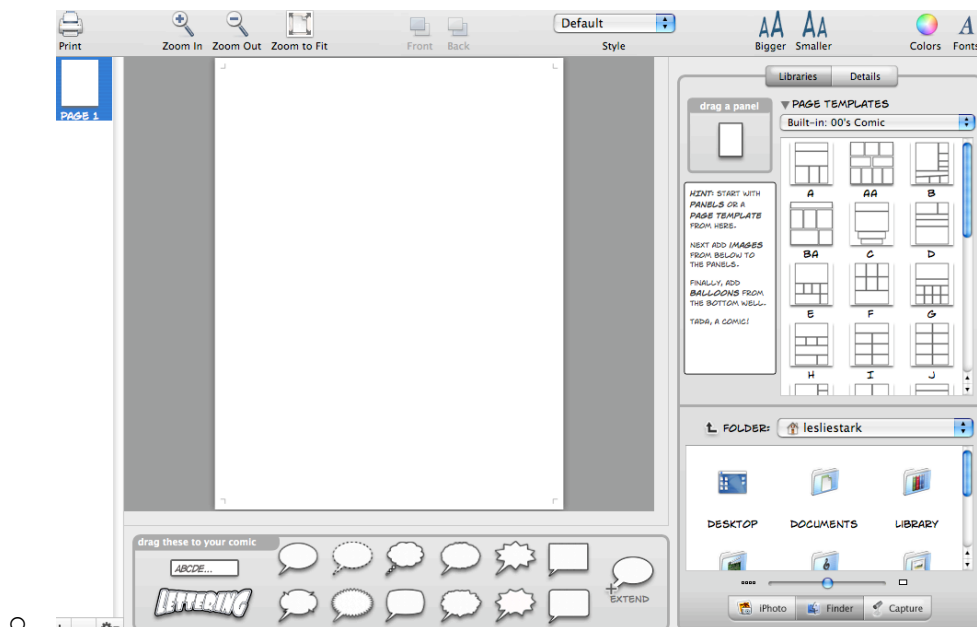
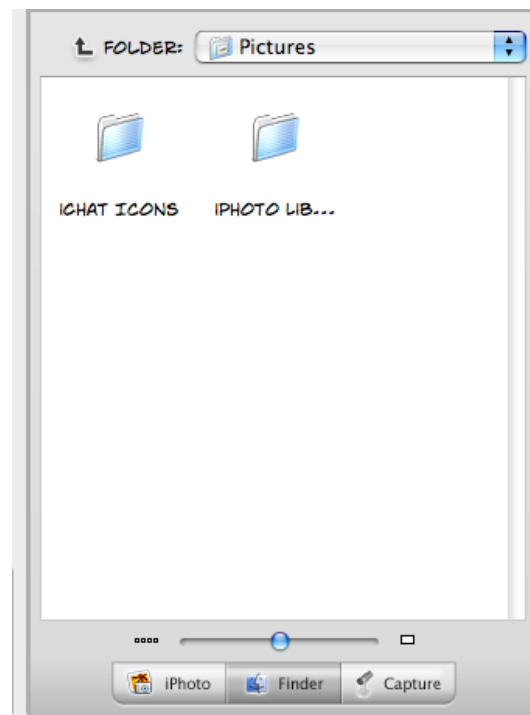


Comic Life Tutorial

- What is Comic Life?
 - Comic Life is an application allowing students to easily create comic book pages or an entire comic book. It allows students to use their own images and drawings as panels.
- Accessing Comic Life...
 - Comic Life is located in your applications folder.
- Working with Comic Life...
 - Once you have opened comic life, a blank sheet will appear. You will need to select the template you would like to use.
 - There are many options ranging from Comic book era to foreign style to standards.
 - To select a template simply click on the template you like and drag it to the blank page.



- After selecting a template the next step is to add pictures. Images may either come from I-Photo or from your library of pictures/images. If students have created or gathered their own artwork save it in the pictures file folder.



- Once the student has found the picture or image they are interested in they simply grab and drop it into the frame in which it should appear.
 - At that time they can manipulate the photo, by rotating, shrinking, and stretching.
 - Continue to drag photos/images in to the template until the storyboard is set.
- To add titles to simply drag and drop either a word or thought bubble. To add commentary about a scene add the “ABCDE...” box.



- After adding commentary, titles you'll have a relatively finished product.
- Students can continue to create more pages or print out their current page.
